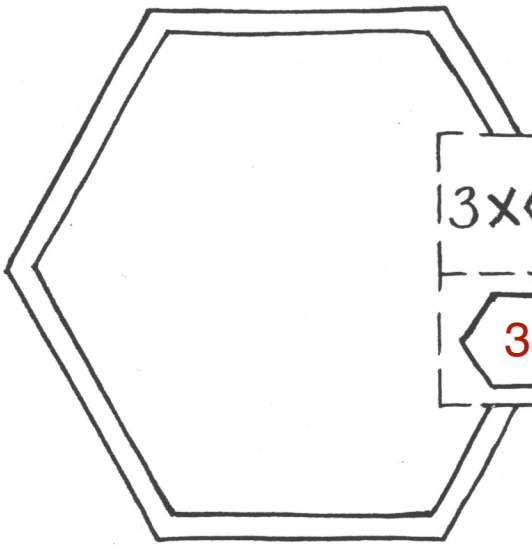
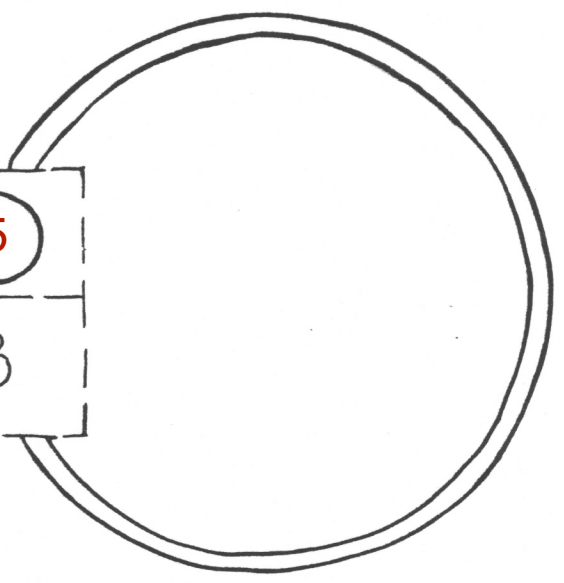
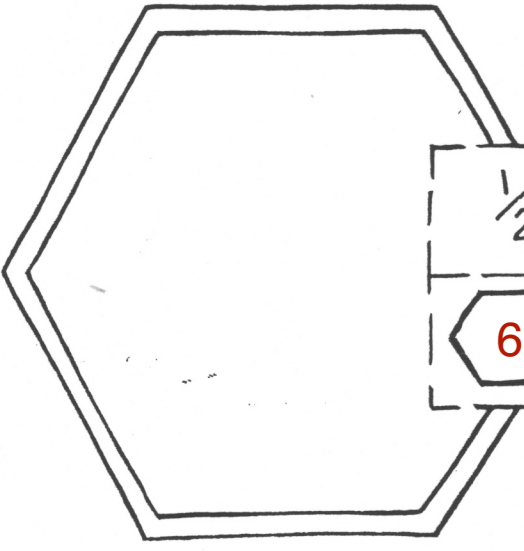
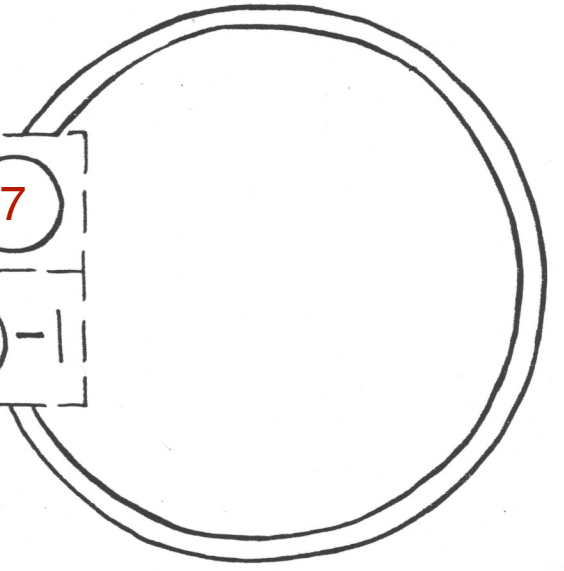


$$2 \times \text{2} + 1 = \text{5}$$
